

#### Background

#### Version 0: 2006-2007

- Continuation and maintenance of past Sea-Search system
  - No standardized information

#### Version 1: 2008-2010

- Setup of the integrated online data service to users :
- The directories were interconnected and fully harmonized in use of syntax, semantics and tools
  - ISO 19115 metadata standard for all directories
  - Common vocabs, EDMERP, EDMO and CSR references in the metadata descriptions
- CSR, EDIOS still need content upgrade
- Version 2: 2010-2011
  - Data product services were added to the infrastructure
  - OGC compliant viewing services
  - Management of additional data types (EMODNET, Geo-Seas, etc)

## SeaDataNet - II (2011-2015)

- Metadata directories (only CDI, CSR) extension with OCG-CS-W components for automatic harvesting from the SDN nodes
- ISO 19139 transport scheme and INSPIRE compliance will be implemented

  - New CDI is ready
  - CSR end of October
  - Mikado, end of 2012





#### **CSR Statistics**

- Altogether ~16500 (of 41400) V1 records (10.09.2012)
- that is more than 42% of all CSRs from SDN partners
- On the whole partners have been quite productive
- 15 countries have completed or almost completed (>90%) upgrading to V1: Albania(1), Belgium, Bulgaria, Ireland, Israel, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta(5), Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Tunisia, Ukraine
- about half of the active partners use CSR online
- the other half submit XML records

#### **CSR Submission since SDN II Kick-Off**

Since 01.10.2011:

- Online CSR submission/updates from: Belgium, Cyprus, Denmark, Germany, Greece, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Romania, Sweden, Tunisia, Ukraine (~1000 records: 2/3 updates)
- XML CSR submission/updates from: Belgium, Croatia, France, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, Spain, Turkey, Ukraine, United Kingdom (~5000 records: 45% updates)
- No new submission from several partners after completing their upgrades
- Regrettably a few partners show no activities at all

### EDMED V1 - content

- Total entries now: 3834 plus ~25 pending (from 36 SDN partners)
- Not many entries received during the year
- BODC will send out an e-mail requesting updates later this month
- Guidance note on content available (soon to be on website)
- SeaDataNet II 'look and feel' implemented

# EDIOS V1

- EDIOS is hierarchical: 3 schemas for observing programmes, series and platforms
- Content received from 11 countries (SDN partners) approx. 5 of these are complete
- 350 observing programmes comprising 16544 series (points, curves and surfaces)
- Guidance note on content being finalised
- Software under development to enable updates (i.e. comparison of new/updated records with existing records at BODC)

### EDMO V1

- Currently around 2700 institutes
- 2266 institutes are based within European countries (others are non-eu for support in SDN directories)
- Activity slow but steady
- Action for NODC's: make at least once a year a check if addresses and websites are still valid!
